Applications for Renewable Energy Leases and Grants and Alternate Use Grants on the U.S. Outer Continental Shelf

Background

On April 22, 2009, President Obama announced that the Department of the Interior finalized the framework for renewable energy production on the Outer Continental Shelf (OCS). A final rule, published in the *Federal Register* on April 29, 2009 (74 FR 19638), establishes a program to grant leases, rights-of-use and easement (RUEs), and rights-of-way (ROWs) for orderly, safe, and environmentally responsible renewable energy and alternate use activities, such as the siting of offshore wind facilities on the OCS.

Applications for renewable energy leases, RUEs and ROWs and alternate use RUEs on the OCS are to be filed with the appropriate MMS Office as outlined below.
