## NOTICE TO LESSEES AND OPERATORS OF FEDERAL OIL AND GAS LEASES IN THE OUTER CONTINENTIAL SHELF

#### **Submitting Semiannual Well Tests Electronically**

This Notice to Lessees and Operators (NTL) explains how you can electronically submit Semiannual Well Tests and supersedes NTL No. 2001-N02.

## **Background**

The Minerals Management Service (MMS) regulations (30 CFR 250.1102(b)(3)) require lessees/operators to conduct well tests at least once every 6 months for each producing completion and submit the results on Form MMS-128, Semiannual Well Test Report. Many operators comply with this requirement by completing and submitting numerous paper copies of Form MMS-128. While it is not currently a regulatory requirement to submit these data electronically, MMS strongly encourages operators to do so.

### **Acceptable Formats**

In addition to paper forms, MMS accepts flat files in either a fixed-length format or comma-delimited format ASCII file. Operators interested in submitting electronic semiannual well test results should follow the instructions at <a href="http://www.gomr.mms.gov/homepg/mmsforms/formMMS-128-inst.pdf">http://www.gomr.mms.gov/homepg/mmsforms/formMMS-128-inst.pdf</a> that explain the acceptable formats in more detail.

Since all data required on Form MMS-128 are public information, most operators are comfortable with submitting the flat files as e-mail attachments. If you prefer, you may also mail the file(s) on a compact disk (CD).
